



Adjuvant Therapy - this is treatment given after a patient's main course of care has been completed. Its purpose is to prevent cancer from coming back by destroying any remaining cancer cells. Adjuvant therapy is usually chemotherapy, radiation therapy, hormone therapy and/or immunotherapy given after surgery.

On the other hand, neoadjuvant therapy is treatment given before surgery to shrink a tumor so that it is easier to remove.
