Medicare Open Enrollment Begins Wednesday, October 15!

The Medicare Open Enrollment Period starts October 15 and ends December 7, 2025.

During this time period, Medicare patients are able to make changes to their Medicare coverage. These changes will take effect on January 1, 2026.



- Medicare patients have a choice to either:

 Enroll with a Medicare Advantage Plan (please make sure this plan is participating with your physicians) or

 Enroll with Medicare & a Supplemental Plan.

** Please also make sure you are enrolled with pharmacy coverage when reviewing either plan type. Failure to have pharmacy coverage may result in penalties.**

If you are unable to attend this free screening event -- Anyone who meets the above criteria can contact HOA's <u>Lungs for Life Program</u> at 315-472-7504 to arrange a lung cancer screening at a time convenient for them. The Lungs for Life Program is a lung cancer screening scan and appointment with a healthcare provider to review results and recommendations. In most cases insurance will pay for the testing. It can also be paid out-of-pocket for approximately \$250.
